As educators, we should provide as many year-round learning experiences as possible that reflect our students' intersecting identities along with the lessons that offer insights into others with whom they may not have a deep understanding or appreciation. The value of offering these *mirrors and windows* is well established and should be provided thoughtfully and consistently in our nation's classrooms.

LGBTQ+ Pride Month is celebrated primarily in the month of June to honor the 1969 Stonewall Uprising in Manhattan. The Stonewall Uprising was a tipping point for the Gay Liberation Movement in the U.S. though LGBTQ activism dates back to the 1920s. Drag queens Marsha P. Johnson and Sylvia Rivera are among those recognized as major participants in the Stonewall Uprising. In June 1970, on the first anniversary of the Stonewall Riots, thousands of people marched in New York from the Stonewall Inn to Central Park, recognized by many as the first gay parade in the U.S. Initially, the last Sunday in June was celebrated as *Gay Pride Day*, but the actual day was flexible. In major cities across the U.S., the *day* evolved into a monthlong series of events. Today, celebrations include pride parades, picnics, parties, workshops, symposia and concerts. These celebratory events attract millions of participants around the world and serve to recognize the impact that lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender individuals have had on history locally, nationally and internationally. Presidents Clinton, Obama and Biden have recognized Pride Month during their respective terms of office.

It is particularly important to recognize LGBTQ+ Pride Month this year as LGBTQ+ youth and adults are currently facing increased harassment and discrimination in many states across our country. *Movement Advancement Project* has reported that just in the first two months of 2023, 45 states had introduced at least 580 anti-LGBTQ bills with more than 160 of them being LGBTQ school-specific ones. From censoring discussions of LGBTQ+ people to banning transgender students from athletic activities, many of these proposals are becoming laws. Book bans, removing anti-bullying/harassment protections for LGBTQ+ youth, firing or suing teachers supportive of LGBTQ+ youth, and forcing teachers to out students to parents are among the other outcomes of recent legislation. As an adult member of the LGBTQ+ community, I am both angered and concerned that this is happening in our country and can only imagine how this discriminatory climate is affecting our LGBTQ+ youth in schools. In California, we must remain steadfast in our support of *all* of our marginalized youth and adults, and not take their hard-won protections for granted!

While the custom of cultural monthly observances may seem out-of-date, please consider them as additional opportunities to highlight the achievements and contributions of a particular group of our citizenry in greater depth — a worthy goal. At a time when there is a critical need to promote acceptance, respect and harmony throughout our diverse communities, please consider engaging students in experiences that lead to a greater appreciation of the collective contributions made by others of similar, as well as differing, identities. Please also remember to provide adequate context to these accomplishments in light of the challenges our marginalized citizenry had to overcome to reach their goals. Hopefully, these learning experiences help students understand we are all woven into the rich cultural tapestry of humanity in this place we call America.


